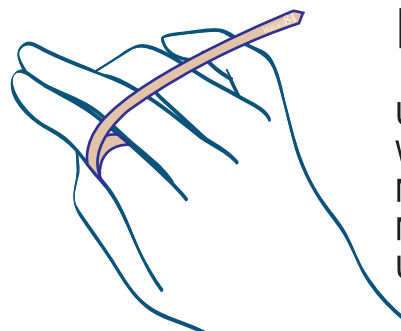
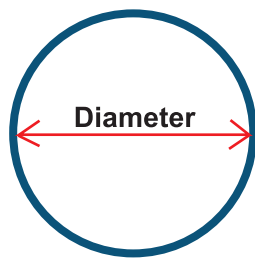
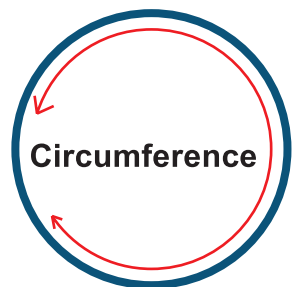

How to measure

Use a piece of thin strip paper or threads
Wrap it around your finger.

Make sure the paper is below the joint of your finger and close to your knuckle.
Mark the spot where the paper meets and measure the distance with your ruler.
Use above chart to determine your ring size.
